

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, SWANAGE, FOR CARNIVAL PROCESSION AND ACCESS, SUNDAY 28th JULY 2024

For the purpose of Swanage Carnival Procession and access, DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and the emergency services on Sunday, 28th July 2024 -

- (A) Shore Road (north of Victoria Ave, Victoria Ave (between DeMoulham Road and Shore Road) **07.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs;**
- (B) Walrond Road, DeMoulham Road (part) and Rabling Road, **08.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs;**
- (C) DeMoulham Road (part), Clifton Road, Institute Road, High Street (between Institute Road and Kings Road East junctions), Kings Road East, Kings Road West (between Kings Road East and Station Road junctions), Station Road, Rempstone Road, Victoria Avenue **12.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs;**
- (D) High Street (Institute Road junction to Seymer Road junction) **12.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs;**
- (E) Church Hill one-way system will be REVERSED **12.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs;**
- (F) Clearways, as indicated by signs on site, will be imposed between **07.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs** on two sections of road:
 - (i) Northbrook Road between its junctions with Bonfields Avenue and Victoria Avenue;
 - (ii) Victoria Avenue between its junctions with Northbrook Road and Rabling Road.

No waiting or parking will be allowed upon the highway or verge in these locations. Vehicles in breach of these clearways will be towed away.

Alternative routes will be signed for diverted traffic.

(A)-(D) - Marshals will be stationed at strategic points to ensure only emergency vehicles and those taking part in the Carnival Procession have access.

(E) - Marshals will be stationed at each end of Church Hill to ensure compliance with the reversal of the one-way system.
