

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PARTS OF SHORE ROAD AND VICTORIA AVENUE, SWANAGE FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAYS, 27th JULY, 31ST July & 3rd AUGUST 2024

For the safety of spectators at the Swanage Carnival Fireworks Displays, DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation [Special Events] Act 1984 to prohibit the use of part of Shore Road between Clifton Road and Victoria Avenue and Victoria Avenue between Shore Road and De Moulham Road, Swanage by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and Emergency Services, as follows:

Saturday 27th July, Wednesday 31st July and Saturday 3rd August 2024 between 20.30 and 23.00 hrs

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be from the North via Clifton Road, DeMoulham Road, Victoria Avenue and vice versa.
