

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EASTERN PART OF WALROND ROAD, SWANAGE, FOR USE AS A COMPOUND IN CONNECTION WITH CARNIVAL EVENT MANAGEMENT, 26<sup>th</sup> JULY – 3<sup>rd</sup> AUGUST 2024

In order to facilitate the management of carnival events, DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the eastern part of Walrond Road, Swanage from the junction with Shore Road to the junction with De Moulham Road by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the events and the emergency services:

**Between 07.00 hrs, 26<sup>th</sup> July and 23.59 hrs, 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2024**

There will be no signed alternative route for diverted traffic on this occasion.

A temporary parking restriction will be in place along De Moulham Road between Walrond Road and the A351 for the safety of pedestrians and traffic entering the Carnival Showground on Sandpit Field, to allow parking of vehicles necessary for the running of the event and for unhindered access for emergency services should they be required between 07.00hrs on Friday 26th July to 23:59 on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2024.
