

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS STREETS IN SWANAGE FOR A WHEELBARROW RACE, FRIDAY 2nd AUGUST 2024

For the purpose of a Wheelbarrow Race, DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation [Special Events] Act 1994 to prohibit the use of Station Road, Institute Road, High Street, Town Hall Lane, Encombe Road and parts of Kings Road West, Kings Road East, Shore Road and Seymer Road, Swanage by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and the emergency services on Friday, 2nd August 2024 between 19.00 hrs and 20.00 hrs.

Traffic flow at Church Hill will be reversed for this period. Also traffic flow will be reversed in southbound carriageway of Kings Road West between the Station Road and Kings Road East junctions. Northbound traffic in Kings Road West will be diverted via Springfield Road (Bus Station) to Rempstone Road.

Marshals will be stationed at strategic points to advise motorists of alternative routes if required, and to ensure only emergency vehicles and those taking part in the Wheelbarrow Race have access. Marshalls will also be stationed at each end of Church Hill to ensure compliance with the reversal of the one-way system.
